The Japanese for Busy People Revised 4th Edition series consists of three volumes: Book I (romanized version and kana version), Book II, and Book III. The first edition of Japanese for Busy People II was published in 1990 for people who wished to progress to the next step after studying Japanese for Busy People I, which was published in 1984. In the first revision of Japanese for Busy People II, the textbook was divided into two books: Book II and Book III, the former of which was published in 1994, followed by the latter, published in 1995. For the third revision in 2007, a variety of changes were made, such as grouping the lessons into units, adding new features such as Word Power and Phrase Power, and expanding the dialogues. These changes were made to clarify the situations for practical use of Japanese based on the latest results of research in Japanese-language education and to help learners feel confident in their communication skills.
